

June 2021 All-Star Roster Facts

Here are some facts regarding the June 2021 All-Star Game rosters (players and coaches):

1. Player totals by MSHSL class:

1A 3, 2A 7, 3A 14, 4A 18, 5A 19, 6A 25, 9M 2

2. Sub-Districts with players on both rosters = 7:

East Central-South, Metro-East, Metro-West, North Central-White, Suburban-Blue, Suburban-Red, Twin City-Blue

3. Most players (one school) = 3: Albany, Eden Prairie

4. Most players (one Sub-District) = 8: Metro-West

5. Most consecutive years represented = 22: Totino-Grace 2000-2021 (two games in 2016)

Record is 23 years – Stillwater 1976-1998

6. Largest and smallest schools represented:

Largest = Prior Lake (enrollment 2,722), Smallest = Hancock (enrollment 109)

7. First player representative in June 2021 (2): Academy Force, Murray County Central

8. In June 2021, these schools have player representatives in the All-Star Football Game for the first time in more than 10 years:

Concordia Academy (2010), Hancock (1997), Hills-Beaver Creek (1991), Medford (2004), Milaca (2007), Mora (2010), Richfield (2011)

9. Highest player participation overall in the last 10 games (2012 to June 2021 – two games in 2016):

10. Number of All-State players = 16 (down from 38 in 2019)

11. Number of First Team All-State players = 8 (down from 17 in 2019)

12. Number of NCAA Division I (FBS) players = 0

13. Number of NCAA Division IAA (FCS) players = 10

14. Second generation All-Star players (their fathers or grandfathers also played in the All-Star Game):

- Cade Kramer, South, Eden Prairie (Grandfather Tom Moe 1956 North / Edina-Morningside, North Captain, University of Minnesota Athletics Director)

15. Announcer's nightmare: the two South quarterbacks are from Richfield and Litchfield.

16. Matt Lundeen will be an Assistant Coach for the South. He is also a former All-Star player:

Becker (player), 1994 QB (Outstate)
Redwood Valley (coach) 2021.1 Assistant Coach (South)

17. Fifth time since 1974 that both head coaches are from Metro area schools (Rogers and Shakopee).

Also 1976, 1978, 2015, December 2016

18. Both head coaches are in their second All-Star Game coaching assignment (Marc Franz was a Metro assistant in 2009 and Ray Betton was a South assistant in 2014).
19. Ray Betton is the first All-Star coach from Shakopee since Dale Vaughan in 1982 (39 years).
